

竹濤武術中心簡介



竹濤武術中心是由馮以德博士於1980年所創立,至今已屆滿廿九週年。馮博士(Sensei Yee-Tak Fung)擁有空手道五段,並精研太極拳,中國武術及刀、劍、棍、扇、峨嵋刺、雙節棍等多種武器。雖然馮博士於2004年仙逝,但是他大部份的功夫已傳承下來。目前中心是由李仲森(Sensei Jong-Sen Lee)擔任總教練。李教練擁有空手道三段,同時研習太極拳,中國武術及多種武器。目前該中心已培養多位年輕一輩的黑帶教練主持各分校。

本中心以傳授空手道及太極拳為主。教學宗旨除了在於鍛練強健的體魄與自衛防禦術之外,並特別著重武德訓練,以培養學生堅忍不拔、 鍥而不捨、不卑不亢及自律自信的精神。在29 年以後,事實證明,凡是由中心畢業的學生, 目前在職場上更是獨領風騷;同時中心的教練都是上上之選。

中心位於惠特曼高中(Walt Whitman HS, MD)。空手道班設有神龍(華府中文學校)、祥龍(慈濟中文學校)及北維中文學校等三所分校。成人太極拳班則名為雅竹,設於美京華人活動中心 (Tilden MS, MD),由陳鳳凰、師秋萍及蕭麗娥主持。太極拳班以傳授楊式太極拳與馮博士自創的音韻太極拳為主,活動時間為每週六下午12:00-3:00。

空手道學生依程度分級佩戴色帶,分別為白、 黃、紫、藍、綠、褐及黑帶。升上黑帶即成為 本中心教練,並可繼續研習更上乘的武術及武 器。學校開學期間,所有空手道班學生每週末 均於各所屬的分校上課;每週五晚上7:00-10:00則集中在中心(Walt Whitman HS, MD)上 課、練習,同時家長們可以同時在此修習太 極。此外,中、高級學生並可於每週二晚上 7:00-8:30至該中心加強集訓,其中前半段時間 是提供給所有綠帶以上的學生。

本中心每年均開設暑期訓練班。今年自6月19日起至7月27日為止,每週二及週五晚上7:00-8:30在惠特曼高中餐廳(Walt Whitman HS, MD)上課。所有新生只要年齡八歲以上,不分大人小孩,有興趣學習空手道者,均可免費加入受訓。The Walt Whitman High School (7100 Whittier Boulevard, Bethesda, MD 20817)離George C. Marshall High School, VA 只有16分鐘的路程,歡迎前往參觀。

The Jue Tao Martial Art Center is a non-profit organization that has been promoting and providing martial arts training in the metropolitan DC area since 1980. The martial arts training include Karate, Tai-Chi, and other branches of martial arts. All Sensei of the center are volunteers. The Center was founded by Sensei Yee-Tak Fung (馮以德老師) in 1981, and currently has four branch schools throughout Washington area and a central training facility at Whiteman High School to serve the community. Each year, about one hundred students are enrolled in the training program; many come from the same family. Over the past twenty some years, thousands of students have benefited from the training. Unfortunately, Sensei Tak passed away on June 17, 2004. He is a highly respected and honorable master in martial arts and a prominent leader of the Center for the past 29 years.

Sensei Tak has trained thousands of students and developed numerous training materials and programs. Students have performed and demonstrated martial arts in many occasions and festivals in the community. The discipline, perseverance, confidence and modesty acquired through many years of vigorous training enrich their life and contribute to the success of their career. Sensei Tak have not only demonstrated strong leadership in Karate, but they have also been the source of inspiration for their students. With their strong leadership, clear vision, and dedication, the Jue Tao Center will continue to maintain its reputation as an outstanding and one of the most prestigious martial art centers.

Through intensive and vigorous training, students in the Karate Program move up in ranks recognized by the color of their belts: White, Blue, Green, Brown, and Black. Forty-eight students have attained the Black Belt rank and many of them are serving as instructors at branch schools. As Sensei Tak often mentioned, attaining the Black Belt is only the beginning of a long journey towards mastering Marital Arts. As many Black Belt students continue practicing Karate, the Center currently has formal program for recognizing their achievements beyond the Black Belt, promoting to Shodan (First Degree Black Belt), Nidan (Second Degree Black Belt), etc. To enhance the Post-Black-Belt training, the Center has developed training materials and programs for students to advance beyond the Black Belt.

The Jue Tao center teaches Karate, Tai-Chi, and other forms of martial arts. Karate training takes place at Walt Whitman High School, Bethesda, MD every Tuesday and Friday nights. Tuesday night training sessions are only for HIGHER-ranked students (Brown belts and above). As for Friday night training sessions are open for students of all ranks and the training time runs from 7pm to 10pm. During this time period, parents can also join Tai-Chi class if interested.

Sensei Jeffery Chang and Sensei Tim Yee are team coaches of NVCS. Sensei Jeffery Chang graduated from Georgetown University in Washington, DC, and is also a certified CPA (Certified Public Accountant) and CFA (Chartered Financial Analyst) by the age of 26. Sensei Tim Yee graduated from Cornell University, located in Ithaca, New York. Both of them are working for two different remarkable International companies and are also very successful in theirs fields.

Together, they are thankful for Sensei Tak's training and with his help, they were able to successful concentrate on their academics and career with integrity and triumph. Volunteering to teach karate and contributing growing experiences at NVCS with students is greatly appreciated while students also look up to these sensei as role models and someone who they would like to become in the future.
